



GRADE ONE SUPPLY LIST 2024-2025

**Parents are responsible to supply the following:
(PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS)**

- 1 school bag (large enough for lunch kit and school work), 1 lunch box or bag. We encourage students to bring their food and drinks in reusable containers. One of our learning outcomes for science is to “demonstrate ways to reduce, reuse, and recycle materials” and reducing our lunch waste and reusing our lunch containers is a practical application of this objective.
- 1 pair indoor running shoes – Please supply your child with running shoes that are easy to put on and take off. We change our shoes multiple times each day. Please note, we will usually be unable to assist students in the tying of their shoe laces. Please practice this at home. No deck shoes, canvas shoes or “fashion” runners.
- 1 set headphones (1/8” or 3.5 mm jack)
- 2 box of Kleenex – **NOT LABELLED**
- 1 leak proof water bottle, preferably one with a pop-up sip spout instead of a wide mouth opening because it is less likely to spill when accidentally tipped over.
- 10 large Ziploc bags – **NOT LABELLED**
- 1 pair of scissors (good quality and labelled)

Bulk supplies will be purchased by the classroom teachers. Please send in payment of \$55.00 on the first day of school (cheques can be made out to WMS).

The teacher will purchase bulk supplies and necessary student resource materials such as:
Markers, writing journals, outdoor learning material, Special Events (Mother’s Day, Father’s Day, Christmas) etc.

Phys. Ed. When coming to PE each student should wear clothes that are comfortable and easy to move around in. Try to avoid skirts and dresses on PE days. Gear more towards pants or shorts, and a comfortable shirt. This will make it easier to move around, and not have to worry about what you are wearing. Wear running shoes with good support and each student should be able to tie their own laces.

When shopping for school clothing, please be reminded that our school’s code of conduct also refers to appropriate attire. We appreciate parental support in supplying children with suitable clothing for the school setting. Make sure to label all clothing, including hats, mittens, and boots, to make it easier to return misplaced items.
